Q.1. Amit of Bombay consigned 150 T.V. sets at Rs. 4,000 each to Nitin of Nagpur. He paid Rs. 24,000 for freight and Rs.4000 for wages. Nitin took delivery of the T.V. sets and paid Rs. 40,000 for Octroi and other charges.

The consignee accepted a bill of Rs. 1,60,000 drawn by the consignor for 3 months. The consignee sent an account sale after two months stating that he has sold 120 Sets at Rs. 6,000 each and paid Rs. 10,000 for advertisement and other selling expenses. The consignee is entitled to a commission of 4% on gross sale proceeds.

Kamal Traders sold 300 calculators at Rs. 900 each. Kamal Traders are entitled to a commission of 15% and 10% on excess of invoice price realised.

Kamal Traders spent Rs. 5,000 for selling expenses.

Kamal Traders accepted a bill of Rs. 60,000 as an advance and remitted the balance to consignor along with Account sales.
